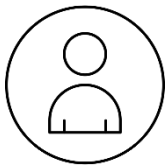


Health & Safety charter of commitment

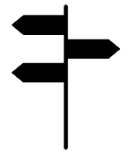
A designated person responsible for ensuring the measures are observed who works exclusively on putting in place stricter health and safety measures, and their implementation

Staff training with regards to the new health and safety standards, observing protective measures and adjusting facilities



Reorganised front desk and reception areas fitted with protective glass shields as an added precaution with regards to social distances.

Special signs and markings as a reminder of good practices with regards to protective measures. "Markings" are also present in areas that require a specific visitor flow or increased social distancing..



Safe commons areas disinfection of all common areas and contact areas (lifts, door handles, light switches, telephones) several times a day. Sanitisation of surfaces in line with stringent standards, with specific signage to indicate when each disinfection has been carried out

Improved hygiene alcohol-based sanitising gel available in all public areas.



Daily disinfection of all guest rooms and public areas in line with a strict protocol using certified equipment and products that pose no threat to your health.
